Criteria for MGSM's second degree or second concentration Grant

The following guidelines will be implemented on July 1, 2015 for students who enroll for a second degree or second concentration during the 2016-2017 year.

Second Degree at No Tuition Cost Criteria

- Grant applies to students who enrolled in fall of 2012 and forward. Students who enrolled in MGSM prior to fall 2012 are not included in the grant for the second degree at no tuition cost
- Student must be in good academic and financial standing
- A student has one year (12 months) from the date of graduation from the first master's degree at MGSM to begin coursework for the second degree at no tuition cost
- Once enrolled, the following withdrawal policies will be in effect:
 - After completion of a minimum of 1 quarter, a student who withdraws for only 1 quarter will continue to receive the grant for the period of the grant
 - After completion of a minimum of 1 quarter, a student who withdraws for 2 consecutive quarters or more, will return to the grant offered at the time of return if a grant is being offered
 - A student who does not complete the quarter in which they register for the second degree will have to go through an appeal process for the grant on returning to the program.
- The grant will cover tuition up to 18 months from the original enrollment date for the second degree.
- If the second degree is not completed within 18 months from original enrollment date, the remaining courses will be at full tuition cost
- Student must be accepted to the degree program
- All registration, lab, and book fees are not covered in the tuition grant
- One second concentration can be taken in addition to the second degree at no tuition cost

Second Concentration at No Tuition Cost Criteria

- The grant for the second concentration at no tuition cost is open to all MGSM alumni in good academic and financial standing
- A student has one year (12 months) from the date of graduation from the first master's degree at MGSM to begin coursework for the second concentration at no tuition cost
- Once enrolled the following withdrawal policies will be in effect
 - After completion of a minimum of 1 quarter, a student who withdraws for only 1 quarter will continue to receive the grant for the grant period
 - After completion of a minimum of 1 quarter, a student who withdraws for 2 consecutive quarters or more, will return to the grant offered at the time of return if a grant is being offered
 - A student who does not complete the quarter in which they register for the second concentration will have to go through an appeal process for the grant on returning to the program.

- The grant will cover tuition up to 12 months from the original enrollment date for the second concentration.
- If the second concentration is not completed within 12 months of enrollment, the remaining courses will be at full tuition cost
- Student has to be accepted to the concentration
- All registration, lab, and book fees are not covered in the second concentration grant
- Only one second concentration can be taken at no tuition cost
- A second degree at no tuition cost can be taken in addition to a second concentration
- Students, who complete a second concentration, will have it added to their graduate transcript as a second concentration. A degree will not be granted
