WHAT TO BRING

ESSENTIALS

- Alarm clock
- Iron, ironing board and clothes hangers
- Laundry detergent and laundry basket or bag
- Linens/blankets and pillows (beds use extra-long twin sheets)
- Toiletries and any needed pharmaceutical supplies
- Towels and washcloths
- Wastebasket
- Micro fridge Combo or Small Microwave and Mini-fridge

OTHER CONSIDERATIONS

- School supplies
- Computer/laptop

- Television
- Flashlight

THINGS NOT TO BRING (NOT PERMITTED)

- Candles and incense
- Animals, pets
- Bed, couch, extra chairs
- Open coil cooking appliances (such as toaster or coffee pot)
- Electric blanket
- Space Heater
- Fireworks, firearms, explosives, or other weapons, replicas or facsimiles
- Halogen lamp
- Hoover board

FURNITURE PROVIDED

- Extra-long twin bed
- Wardrobe closet, including two drawers
- Desk
- Desk Chair
